

REGULATIONS

ORGANISATION

- 1 Croydon & District Motor Club LTD will organise a Touring Assembly to be known as The Terry Douce Memorial Three Counties Tour on Sunday 20th May 2018.
- 2 The Event will be run under a Certificate of Exemption issued by The Motor Sports Association Ltd. and will be governed by these regulations and any further written instructions issued by the organisers.
- 3 MSA Certificate of Exemption No. 107114.

ELIGIBILTY

- 4 The event is open to all four-wheeled cars and three wheeled cars of "Morgan or Reliant" type registered for the road and over 20 years old. Later "interesting" cars will be considered by the Organisers and accepted at their discretion.
- 5 All cars must be registered and have a valid MOT certificate and insurance cover for road use. Entrants will be required to sign a declaration to that effect before being allowed to participate.
- 6 No competition licence is required but drivers will be asked to produce a valid driving licence at signing-on.

ENTRIES

- 7 Entries open on publication of these regulations and will close on Monday 11th May 2018. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the entry fee of £50.00 and returned to the Secretary of the Meeting at the address below. (Cheques to be made payable to Croydon & District Motor Club please and not to the organisers personally.)
- 8 The entry fee will include two breakfasts at the start, two buffet lunches at the finish a Rally Plate and all documentation
- 9 Final Instructions will be posted one week before the event.

- 11 Maximum number of entries on the tour is forty (40) and the minimum is twenty (20). In the unlikely event that the minimum number should not be attained, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the tour.

ROUTE

- 12 The event will start and finish at: Whyteleafe F. C., Church Road, Whyteleafe, Surrey. CR3 OAR
- 13 The route is approximately 80 miles in total and will be defined by a "TULIP" road book issued to entrants at signing-on containing easy to follow diagrams of most road junctions traversed. The route is also entirely on OS 1:50,000 Landranger maps 187 and 188.
- 14 The first car will leave the start at 10.00am with subsequent entrants at one minute intervals.
- 15 There may be codeboards with letters at undisclosed points along the route, these letters should be noted in the appropriate space on your route cards; these may spell a word that will have some significance to the event.

SIGNING ON

17 Please arrive at the start venue at least 60 minutes before your start time to allow sufficient time for breakfast, scrutineering and signing-on. Please ensure you have with you: Driving licence

MOT certificate for your vehicle (if needed).

18 At signing-on, you will be given your Rally Pack which will contain: Road Book, Rally Plate with fixings and Route Card plus appropriate refreshment vouchers.

The Sandcastle Trust exists to enhance the family lives of those affected by rare genetic conditions through the provision of special day trips, short holidays and respite breaks. Our mission is to help affected families escape, for a short time, the emotional, physical and financial strains of their daily lives, build lasting positive family memories and strengthen family relationships.

There is a significant body of academic research that highlights the positive impact that holidays and spending quality time together as a family have on health, wellbeing, happiness and quality of life. This is especially important for families where a member has been diagnosed with a rare genetic condition as life can often be very bleak with little hope of a cure or effective treatments. Some of the diseases are so rare there are often insufficient patients to participate in drug trials and in any event there tends to be a lack of appetite from pharmaceutical companies to invest in research when the market is so small. We believe there needs to be a greater recognition of the impact a family member (be that a child, parent or sibling) being diagnosed with a rare genetic condition has on the rest of the family. A simple break away from their daily struggles can offer holistic respite for the whole family, reduce stigma and social isolation as well as giving families affected by rare genetic conditions the opportunity to experience the same life experiences as other people.

This is a hugely underfunded area. The Sandcastle Trust receives no government funding and is run solely by volunteers who fundraise hard to support as many affected families as possible. All donations to the charity will have an enduring impact on the lives of those affected by rare genetic conditions.
