

SPRING TREASURE HUNT

Organised by Croydon & District Motor Club Limited

Sunday 19th April 2020

REGULATIONS



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1. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all members and friends of Croydon & District Motor Club Ltd

2. FORMAT

The event will be a problem solving, time limit event as defined here in these regulations. Each competitor will be presented at the start with a set of navigation and clues to answer throughout the event. The clues will take the form of questions and photographs to be answered on physical signs and characteristics along the route. All clues can be answered without leaving the car.

3. PERMIT

The event will be authorised by the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association Limited, and an application for an Exemption Permit has been submitted for this event. The event will be authorised also by the Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) Regulations 1969, as amended.

4. START AND FINISH

The event will start and finish at The White Hart, 71 High Street, Godstone RH9 8DU. The first car will leave at 2:30 pm and the remainder will leave at one minute intervals thereafter. The first car will be due to finish at 5:30 pm. Competitors should be at the start no later than fifteen minutes before their start time. Refreshments will be available at the start and finish.

5. ROUTE

The route will be approximately 30 miles in length on metalled roads and is based exclusively on OS map 187. The navigation will be by written instruction.

6. TIMING

Competitors will start at one minute intervals. The event will be timed at an average speed of 10 mph. Competitors will be allowed a total on-the-road time of three hours to complete the event.

7. PENALTIES

To decide the winner, there are a series of penalties that will be applied as follows:

Each clue not correctly answered	5 points
Each photograph not correctly identified or located	10 points
Each minute late at the Finish Control	1 point

Competitors must report at the Finish Control within thirty minutes of their due time. The winner will be the crew that has scored the least number of penalties. Any ties or dead heats may be decided upon the number of people in the car.

8. EQUIPMENT

An extract of OS map 187 (Dorking and Reigate) will be provided by the organisers. You will need pens and pencils to answer the questions.

9. CARS

The treasure hunt is intended for normal, everyday roadworthy cars. Any car considered unsuitable by the organisers will not be permitted to start.

10. INSURANCE

Competitors are reminded that they will be asked to sign a declaration at the start, to the effect that they have valid insurance for participating in a treasure hunt.

11. ROAD SAFETY

As the event will take place on a public highway, all competitors are asked to observe good driving standards and to cause no inconvenience to other road users. The organisers reserve the right to exclude anyone from the results who fails to drive appropriately.

12. AWARDS

An award will be presented to the overall winner.

13. ENTRIES

The maximum number of entries will be 30 cars, the minimum will be 10.

The entry fee will be £10.00 per car for members of Croydon & District Motor Club, and £15.00 per car for non-members, and all entries will be acknowledged upon receipt.
